A Colombian Air Force retired General. He is graduated from the Military Aviation School (Air Force Academy) as a Combat Pilot Officer and Aeronautics Business with a Strategic Planning specialization, He is a pilot and academic instructor, an aeronautic maintenance officer and an Air Defense specialist. He has a National Security and Defense master's degree, and he was graduated of the Senior Business Management Program from INALDE

Like a Combat and Transport pilots he flew more than 7.000 flying hours in planes like Mirage, Kfir, Avro and C-130 Hércules.

During his military career, he was appointed like Commander of Combat Squadron, Flight Training Group, Military Air Transport Command, Air Combat Command No 2, Air Force Command and Control Center Director, Chief of Aeronautics Logistic Headquarters and Air Operations Headquarters, also he was Deputy Commander of the Colombian Air Force and Colombian Military Forces Joint Chief of Staff.

After his active-duty retirement, he was appointed like a CEO of the Colombian Aeronautics Industries Corporation for 5 years. During this time was achieved the implantation of the AS9100 / 9110, ISO 14001, BASC, ISO 28000, and SMS (Safety Management System) standards. Also, He got the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration) MRO certification. During his administration he finished the manufacturing of 25 T-90 training aircraft for the Air Force, depot maintenance to four C-130 Hercules and the upgrade and life extension program to 13 T-27 Tucanos and 2 UH-60 Black Hawks

He is currently acting as President of Lead Consulting Group and member of the Colombian Association of Aerospace Producers, ACOPAER.
