

COMPTIA UK IT EMPLOYMENT SNAPSHOT

2020 Q4

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

There were nearly 200,000 core information technology (IT) job postings in the UK during the fourth quarter of 2020 according to Burning Glass Technologies Labour Insights.

In relation to the entire UK job market, there were 1.79 million total postings for the same 2020 Q4 period. IT postings continue to be a notable share of all UK job postings (11% in Q4 2020).

After the sharp decline in Q2, the number of IT job postings continues to increase, even as uncertainty remains due to COVID-19 and the upcoming effects of the Brexit-EU trade deal. Compared to Q4 2019, IT job postings are up by 17% in Q4 2020 – also a continued upswing when we typically see a lower number job postings in the last quarter of the year compared to the prior Q3. Notes: The number of job postings may vary widely over time. Not all postings translate to a hire. (See “About This Snapshot” on page 3.)

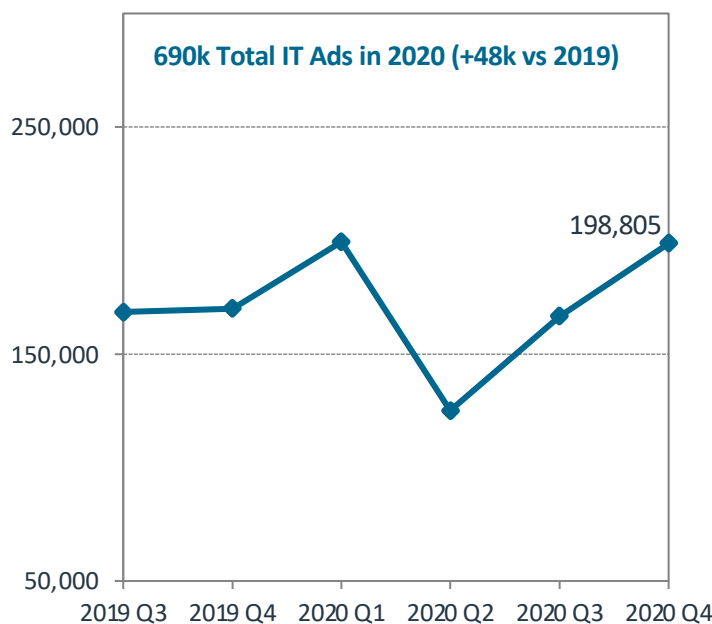
According to the Office for National Statistics, the UK unemployment rate increased to 5.0% for the 3-month period September to November 2020. This is 1.2 percentage points higher vs. a year earlier, as well as 0.6 points higher than for the prior 3 months.

There were 32.50m people in employment September to November 2020 (398,000 fewer than a year earlier and 88,000 fewer than the prior 3 months), vs. 1.72m unemployed people looking for work (418,000 more than the year earlier and 202,000 more than the prior 3 months). However, note the Bank of England Agents’ summary of business conditions – 2020 Q4 points to IT firms performing well and the continued demand for skilled IT professionals.

NUMBER OF CORE IT JOB POSTINGS

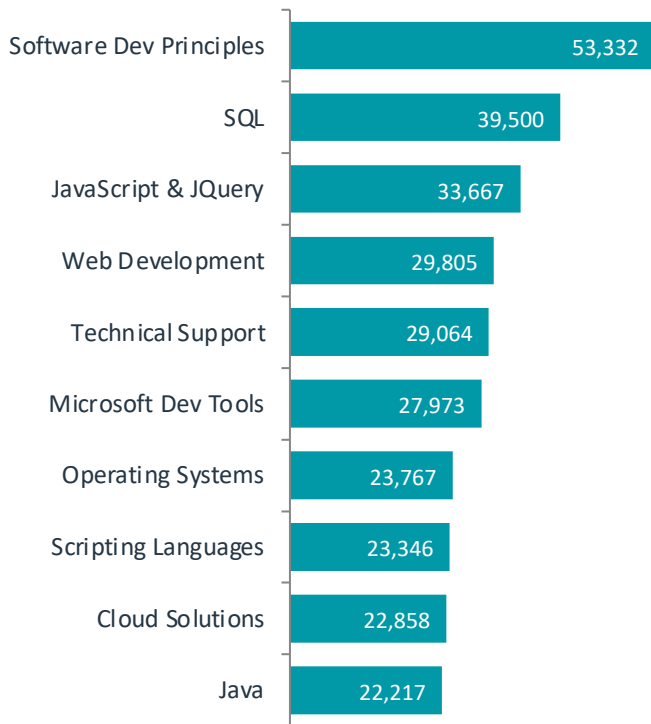

Top Skill Clusters, 2020 Q4



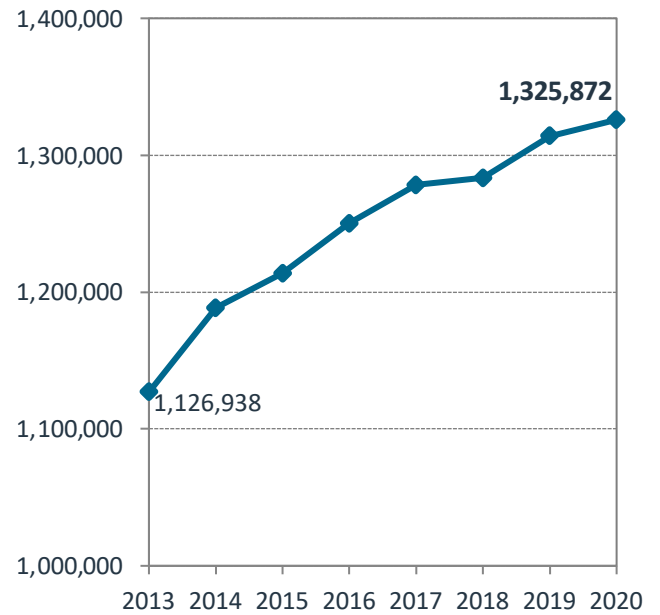

ABOUT THIS SNAPSHOT

The data highlighted in this summary is from Burning Glass Technologies Labour Insights and was pulled January 2021, primarily focusing on 2020 Q4 data. All data is UK only. Additional IT employment data from the ONS and Emsi is also provided. Insight from the [Bank of England](#) is noted as well.

For the purposes of this summary, core IT occupations include positions related to those listed therein. This report excludes certain occupations, such as graphic designer.

Job posting data is a useful, but an imperfect proxy for job demand. Not every posting translates to a new job; hiring firms may change their plans, post multiple times for the same job, hire internally, try different approaches to find the right candidate and so forth. Also, one ad may be posted for multiple openings. Burning Glass Technologies addresses many of these issues, but not all.

CompTIA recommends using job posting data in conjunction with government data to get a more complete picture of labor dynamics for a given occupation category.
